Presentation for Electronic Transmission of Bank Return

Authorised institutions have been informed that the HKMA is considering automating further the submission of returns through electronic transmission, removing the need for physical delivery of diskettes. In this connection, the HKMA has conducted a feasibility study on the initiative and a survey among all institutions of their interest to participate. We are very encouraged by the results of the study and the confirmation by institutions in general of their support for the initiative. We therefore proceeded with a detailed design of the system which has now been completed.

In order to give you an overview of the design of the system, we are pleased to invite your institution to attend a presentation by our consultant to this project, Consultancy Associates Ltd., in April 1997 at our Quarry Bay Office. In the presentation participants will be briefed on the proposed workflow under the electronic transmission system for bank returns, the security of the network and the foreseeable benefit of using the new system.

The participation by each institution will be limited to two representatives and it is most relevant to personnel responsible for the compilation of returns and information technology of the institution.
